Subject: Centralized Test for IT Graduates Leading to Placement in IT Industry

Dear Vice Chancellor / Rector,

As you are well aware that IT industry is continuously evolving at a rapid pace driven by technological advancements, innovation & research, digital transformation and globalization. Along with these challenges, the changing landscape of IT industry is opening up the doors for large number of opportunities and huge demand of IT professionals on variety of skillset, which may be capitalized by strengthening industry-academia linkages and providing an opportunity to enrolled IT students to timely navigate through it.

In this regard, a series of meetings were held amongst the relevant stakeholders including National Computing Education Accreditation Council (NCEAC), Ministry of IT & Telecommunication (MoITT), Pakistan Software Export Board (PSEB), Pakistan IT Industry Association (P@SHA) and Higher Education Commission (HEC) to identify the IT industry-academia gap and ways to improve the market readiness of IT students. As an initial step, in consultation with stakeholders, a centralized test is being planned through Virtual University (VU) for the placement of bright IT students in the industry under academia-industry co-opt program as per details mentioned below;

- The test shall be conducted by Virtual University of Pakistan for the enrolled students of 7<sup>th</sup> semester in computing related disciplines offered in public & private sector universities and affiliated colleges. The list of such disciplines is attached at Annex-A.
- The test shall be conducted on Sunday, 7<sup>th</sup> January 2024. The students may apply on <a href="https://www.vu.edu.pk/GradateTest/">https://www.vu.edu.pk/GradateTest/</a> portal for registration till 31<sup>st</sup> December 2023.
- Students qualifying the test will be offered placement in IT companies including top IT exporters in Pakistan through P@SHA to acquire hands-on experience on real-time projects.
- The qualifying candidates of above-mentioned co-opt program will be considered for an exemption up to 06 credit hours in 8<sup>th</sup> Semester against electives or mandatory field experience.

Spring 2024 will be the first session for the industry placement program.

Upon successful completion of the co-opt program, the credentials of the candidates with recommendations shall be placed on PSEB and P@SHA portals for access of large pool of IT companies leading to job offers.

Your kind support is required to ensure the wide dissemination of the information in your respective university and constituent / affiliated colleges for participation of all the students in target cohort in the upcoming scheduled test.
